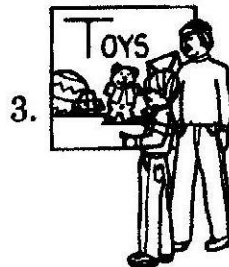

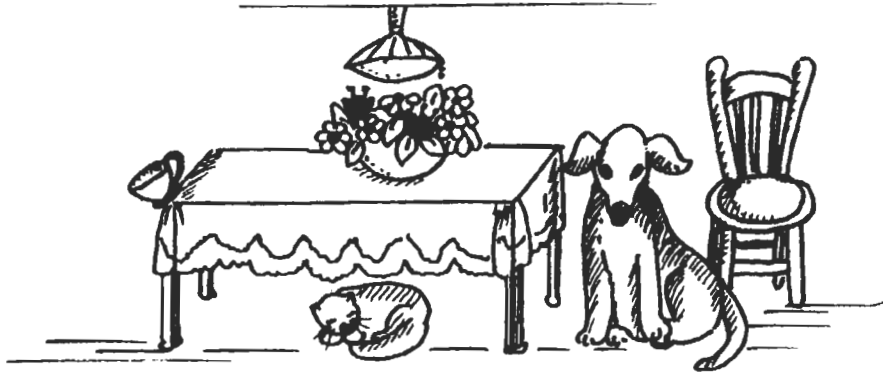

 France is a country in **E**urope.

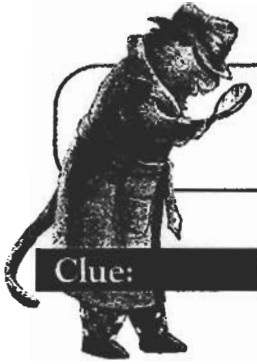
