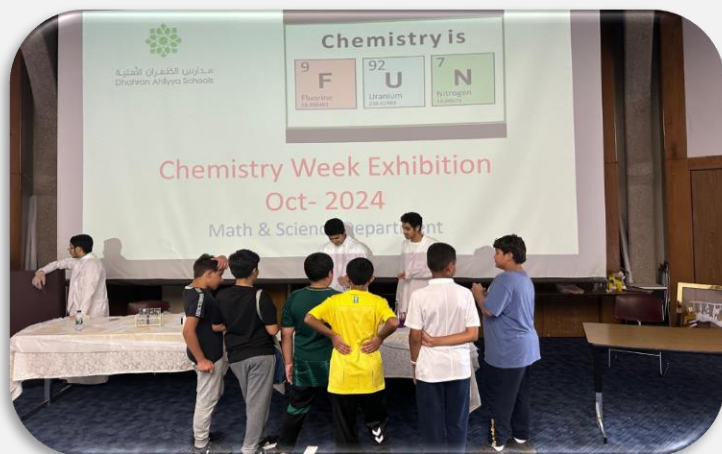




The exhibition featured experiments and interactive activities to deepen students' understanding of chemistry.

Abdulaziz Al-Zamil Wins First Place in the Eastern Province Entrepreneurship Competition

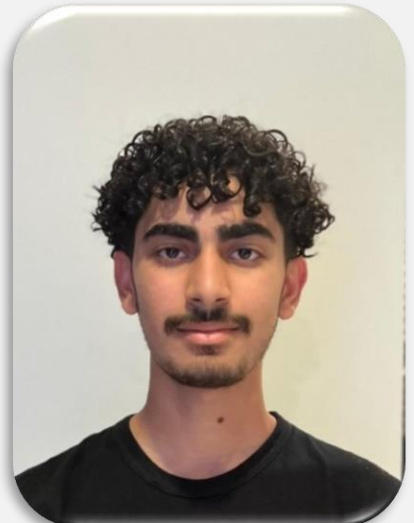
